THIS TERM WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT WORLD WAR 1 AND WORLD WAR 2 AND SO THE HOMEWORK ACTIVITIES REFLECT THIS. AS USUAL WE WILL BE AWARDING HOUSE POINTS FOR EFFORT, TRY COMPLETING AT LEAST ONE ACTIVITY A WEEK.

Draw or paint a poppy for remembrance

Interview someone who remembers the war

Pack your evacuees suitcase (draw and label)

Design a wartime poster to encourage people to either make do and mend or to grow their own fruit and veg

Create a power point on an aspect of WWI or WW2 you find interesting

Create a wartime recipe using your weekly rations

Write a fact file about conditions in the trenches in World War I

Write a letter home to your family as if you've been evacuated, or a soldier away fighting

Draw a diagram of a WW2 aeroplane

Create a fact page on either: Adolf Hitler, Neville Chamberlain or Winston Churchill

Create a front page of a newspaper for the end of the war in Europe

Make a model of a WW2 vehicle (use whatever you like!)

Draw and label or make a shelter from the war, either an Anderson or Morrison shelter and explain how it was used

Make a child's toy from something you might normally throw away or use for something else

Create a WWI or WW2 timeline
